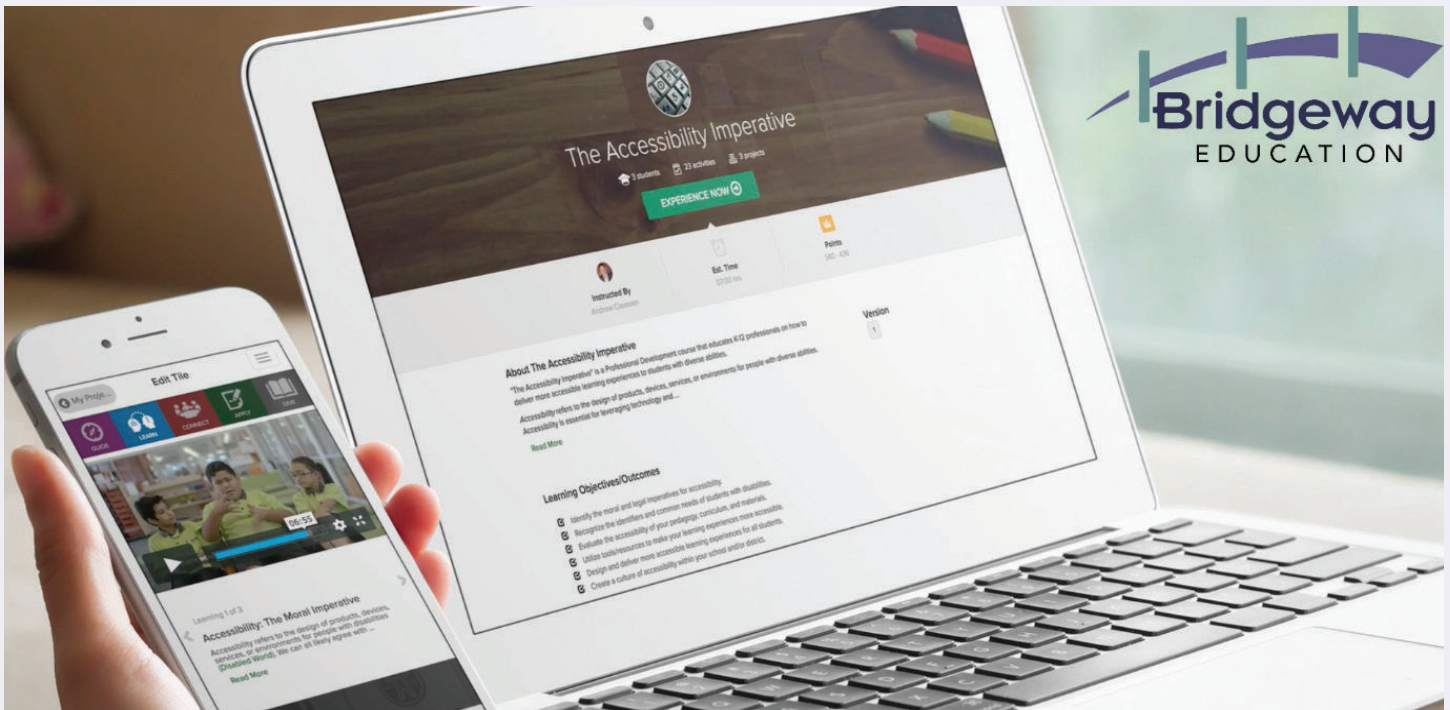


The Accessibility Imperative



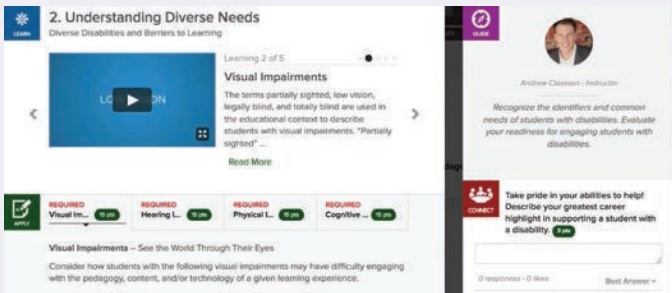
The Accessibility Imperative is a Professional Development course that educates K-12 professionals on how to deliver more accessible learning experiences to students with diverse abilities.

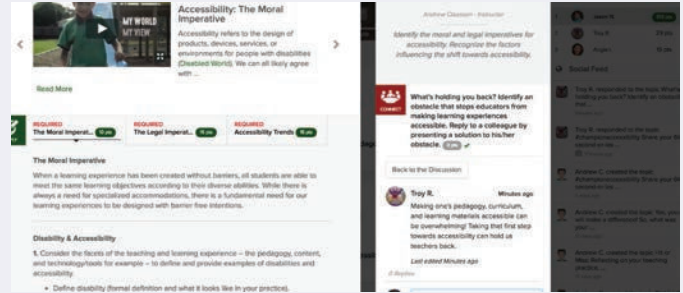

- 6 Create a culture of accessibility at your school or district

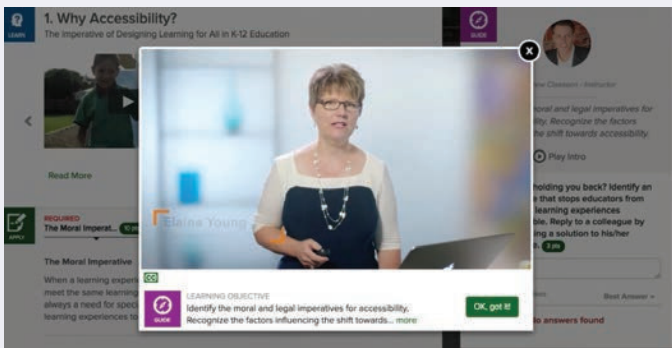

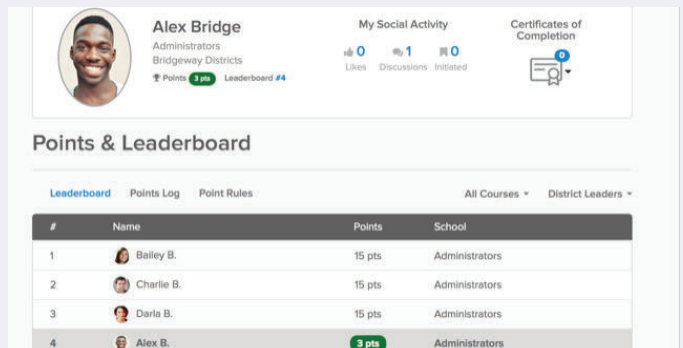
Each section provides valuable information on the needs of a variety of learners and how to develop an accessibility plan.



A unique social networking feature enables collaboration and meaningful discussions to develop among peers.

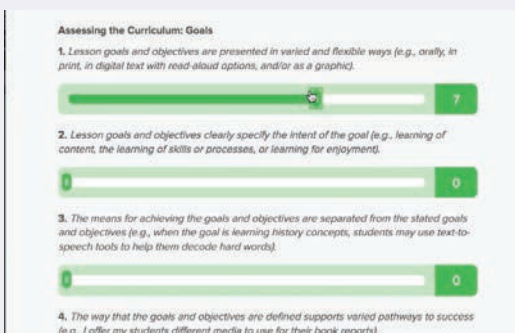


Instructor guidance videos lead educators through the course content and provide real world examples of accessibility solutions.
